Education Grants for Gaelic Teaching Students 2014-2015

Fiosrachadh do Luchd-iarrtais Information for Applicants

Cùl-fhiosrachadh

Chaidh Bòrd na Gàidhlig a stèidheachadh fo Achd na Gàidhlig (Alba) 2005. A-rèir na h-Achd, feumaidh Bòrd na Gàidhlig Plana Cànanain Nàiseanta Gàidhlig uallachadh a h-uile 5 bliadhna.

Tha am Plana Cànanain Nàiseanta Gàidhlig airson 2012-2017 a' comharrachadh 8 raointean leasachaidh air a bheil prìomhachas a thaobh na Gàidhlig, agus 's e 'Foghlam: Sgoiltean is Tidsaran' aonan dhiubh. Sna prìomh amasan ro-innleachdail aige airson foghlaim, tha am Plana a' toirt iomradh sònraichte air mar a dh'fheumar dèanamh cinnteach gun dèanar oidhirpean gu leòr a thaobh a bhith trusadh, a' gleidheadh, agus ag oideachadh luchd-teagaisg airson Foghlam tron Ghàidhlig (FtG) agus Foghlam Gàidhlig do Luchd-ionnsachaidh (FGL) agus a thaobh a bhith leasachadh nan sgilean aca.

Tabhartasan Foghlaim 2014-2015

Tha Bòrd na Gàidhlig air a' mhaoin seo a stèidheachadh gus taic a thoirt do dhaoine a tha ag obair a dh'ionnsaigh a bhith toirt dreuchd a-mach mar neach-teagaisg Gàidhlig. Bu chòir iarrtasan airson taic-airgid a chur a-steach gu Bòrd na Gàidhlig cho luath 's a ghabhas, agus ro **Diluain 15^{mh} Sultain 2014**.

Cò dh'fhaodas cur a-steach?

Gabhaidh sinn ri iarrtasan bho dhaoine a tha dèanamh cùrsa, ann an Ciad-fhoghlam Luchd-teagaisg (ITE), an-dràsta a bheir cothrom dhaibh dreuchd a thoirt a-mach mar neach-teagaisg Gàidhlig.

Gabhaidh sinn beachd air iarrtasan bho:

- Oileanaich a tha a' dèanamh PGDE ann am Foghlam Gàidhlig (airson ìre Bun-sgoile agus Àrd-sgoile – an dà chuid Gàidhlig mar chuspair agus cuspairean tron Ghàidhlig)
- Oileanaich san dà bhliadhna mu dheireadh de Fo-Cheum ann am Foghlam Gàidhlig (BEd, BA no MA Foghlam no MA Gàidhlig le Foghlam)

Uaireannan thèid beachdachadh air iarrtasan bho oileanaich a tha airson cùrsaichean cànanain Gàidhlig a dhèanamh (me cùrsaichean goirid no cùrsaichean air astar) mus tèid iad air adhart gu cùrsa ITE. Thathar an dùil gum

Background

Bòrd na Gàidhlig was established under the powers of the Gaelic Language (Scotland) Act 2005. The Act states that Bòrd na Gàidhlig must produce a National Gaelic Language Plan every 5 years.

The National Gaelic Language Plan 2012-2017 identifies 8 development areas which are a priority for Gaelic, one of which is 'Education: Schools and Teachers'. In its strategic priorities for education, the Plan makes specific reference to ensuring that adequate attention is given to the recruitment, retention, education, support and development of teachers in Gaelic-medium Education (GME) and Gaelic Learners' Education (GLE).

Education Grants 2014-2015

Bòrd na Gàidhlig has set up this fund to support those currently working towards a career in Gaelic teaching. Applications for funding should be submitted to Bòrd na Gàidhlig as soon as possible and no later than **Monday 15th September 2014**.

Who can apply?

Applications are welcomed from individuals currently studying on Initial Teacher Education (ITE) courses leading to a career in Gaelic Teaching.

We will consider applications from:

- Students undertaking a PGDE in Gaelic Education (both Primary and Secondary – Gaelic as a subject and subjects through the medium of Gaelic)
- Students in the final two years of a Gaelic Education Undergraduate Degree, (BEd, BA or MA Education or MA Gàidhlig with Education)

In some cases applications will be considered from students wishing to undertake Gaelic language courses (e.g. short courses or distance learning course) prior to an ITE course. Those who apply for such funding are expected

Math dh'fhaodte gun toir iarrtasan airson taic-airgid mu choinneamh chosgaisean cùrsa Gàidhlig buaidh air an t-sùm dheireannach a bhios ri fhaotainn airson cùrsa ITE.

Fior chorra uair, beachdaichidh Bòrd na Gàidhlig air iarrtasan bho luchd-teagaisg a tha airson cùrsaichean Gàidhlig a dhèanamh agus iad am beachd gluasad gu teagasg ann am FtG. Bu chòir do neach-iarrtais sam bith a tha ag iarraidh seo a dhèanamh maoineachadh iarraidh bhon sgoil / Ùghdarras Ionadail aca anns a' chiad dol-a-mach. Cuideachd feumar bruidhinn ris an Oifigear Trusaidh Luchd-teagaisg aig Bòrd na Gàidhlig mus cuirear a-steach airson taic den t-seòrsa seo.

Mar a chuireas sibh a-steach airson taic-airgid

Sa chiad dol-a-mach bu chòir do luchd-iarrtais an stiùireadh seo a leughadh gu faiceallach. An uair sin bu chòir do luchd-iarrtais am **Foirm-iarrtais** a lìonadh a-steach agus a chur gu Bòrd na Gàidhlig, còmhla ri pàipearan sam bith a tha iomchaidh (litir-aontachaidh bho ionad ITE, dearbhadh air cosgaisean a' chùrsa ma thathar a' cur a-steach airson taic-airgid mu choinneamh chisean cùrsa and litir-dhearbhadh bho Bhuidheann Thabhartasan Oileanach na h-Alba (SAAS)).

Feumaidh luchd-iarrtais innse gu soilleir san iarrtas aca dè an uiread de thaic-airgid a tha iad a' sireadh, agus cò air a tha iad a' dol a chosg airgid sin.

Chan fhaod luchd-iarrtais ach **aon iarrtas** a chur a-steach gu Bòrd na Gàidhlig airson Tabhartas Foghlaim sa bhliadhna ionmhais seo.

Dè an ùine a tha an taic-airgid a' còmhdach?

Bheir sinn beachd air iarrtasan airson na bliadhna ionmhais 2014-15. Chan aontaich sinn ri iarrtasan airson taic-airgid ach airson cùrsaichean a tha gan cumail sa bhliadhna acadaimigeach 2014-15.

Dè an uiread de thaic-airgid as urrainnear a thoirt seachad?

Bheirear beachd air gach iarrtas fa leth.

to have already secured a place on an ITE course and any such application should be discussed with the Gaelic Teacher Recruitment Officer at Bòrd na Gàidhlig prior to submission.

Any applications for funding towards Gaelic language courses may affect the final sum available towards an ITE course.

In exceptional circumstances, Bòrd na Gàidhlig will also consider applications from qualified teachers wishing to undertake Gaelic language courses with a view to transferring to GME. Any applicant in this situation must, in the first instance, seek funding from their school / Local Authority. All applications must also be discussed with the Gaelic Teacher Recruitment Officer at Bòrd na Gàidhlig prior to submission.

How to apply

Applicants should first read these guidelines carefully. Applicants should then complete the **Application Form** and submit this to Bòrd na Gàidhlig, along with any relevant supporting documentation, e.g. a letter of acceptance from an ITE Provider, confirmation of course costs if applying for fees, confirmation letter from the Student Awards Agency for Scotland (SAAS)).

Applicants must provide clear details in their application of how much funding is being applied for, and the purpose of the funding.

Applicants can only submit **one application** to Bòrd na Gàidhlig for an Education Grant in this financial year.

What period of time will the funding cover?

We will consider applications for the financial year 2014-2015. Funding can only be approved for courses running during the academic year 2014-2015.

How much funding assistance can be provided?

Each application will be considered on an individual basis.

Tabhartasan

Cìsean Cùrsa

Cuideachd, faodaidh luchd-iarrtais cur a-steach airson taic-airgid mu choinneamh chìsean cùrsa suas gu **£1,820**. Sa chiad dol-a-mach, feumaidh luchd-iarrtais taic-airgid a shireadh bho Bhuidheann Thabhartasan Oileanach na h-Alba (SAAS). Faodaidh daoine nach fhaigh taic-airgid bho SAAS iarrtas a chur gu Bòrd na Gàidhlig airson cuideachadh.

Ma tha buidheann eile a' pàigheadh airson pàirt de na cìsean, faodaidh luchd-iarrtais cur a-steach gu Bòrd na Gàidhlig airson an còrr de na cìsean (suas gu **£1,820**). Pàighidh Bòrd na Gàidhlig taic-airgid airson cìsean gu dìreach don ionad foghlaim.

Bu chòir do luchd-iarrtais innse gu soilleir san fhoirm-iarrtais ma tha iad airson cur a-steach airson taic-airgid mu choinneamh chìsean cùrsa a bharrachd air tabhartas, agus bu chòir dhaibh **pàipearan iomchaidh** sam bith (me dearbhadh air cìsean cùrsa) **a chur an cois an iarrtais**.

Fior chorra uair, faodaidh neach-iarrtais cur a-steach airson sùim nas motha. Ach bu chòir dhaibh bruidhinn ris an Oifigear Trusaidh Luchd-teagaisg aig Bòrd na Gàidhlig, a dh'fheumas cead iarraidh bhon Leasaiche Foghlaim is Ionnsachaidh mus tèid iarrtas a chur a-steach.

Tabhartasan a bharrachd do dhaoine a tha gluasad gu dreuchd ann an Teagasg Gàidhlig

Tha Bòrd na Gàidhlig cuideachd a' tuigsinn gum bi aig cuid a luchd-iarrtais ris an obair leantainneach aca a leigeil seachad airson cùrsa ITE Gàidhlig a dhèanamh. Mar sin, a bharrachd air an tabhartas àbhaisteach a gheibhear mu bheil fiosrachadh sa chlàr air duilleig 3, thathar cuideachd a' tabhann tabhartas a bharrachd mu choinneamh nan uallaichean ionmhasail a dh'fhaodadh a bhith air daoine a

Grants

Applicants may apply for a basic grant towards the costs of living. The sum available to an applicant will be dependent on the course being undertaken and the year of study as follows:

Course Fees

In addition, applicants may also apply for support towards course fees, up to a maximum of **£1,820**. Applicants must in the first instance seek support from the Student Awards Agency for Scotland (SAAS). Those who do not qualify for support from SAAS may then apply to Bòrd na Gàidhlig for assistance.

If fees are being paid in part by another organisation, applicants may apply to Bòrd na Gàidhlig for the remainder of the course fees (up to a maximum of **£1,820**). Any fees paid for by Bòrd na Gàidhlig will be paid directly to the institution.

Applicants should state clearly on the application form if they wish to apply for course fees over and above a grant and any **supporting documentation** (e.g. confirmation of course fees) **must be provided** with the application.

In exceptional circumstances, an individual applicant may apply for a greater sum. However this should be discussed with the Gaelic Teacher Recruitment Officer at Bòrd na Gàidhlig, who will seek approval from the Head of Education and Learning, before submitting the application.

Top-up Grants for those changing to a career in Gaelic Teaching

Bòrd na Gàidhlig is also aware that some applicants will have to give up continuous employment to undertake a Gaelic ITE course. Therefore top-up grant funding over and above the basic grant funding as stated in the table on page 3 is being offered in recognition of financial commitments a person in this situation could have (e.g. mortgage payments, childcare costs, travel costs, etc).

- Cha bhi teachd-a-steach nas àirde na £18,000 aca **fhad 's a tha an cùrsa a' dol air adhart**
- Tha iad ag aontachadh obair mar Neach-teagaisg Gàidhlig airson co-dhiù 3 bliadhna às dèidh a chèile
- Cuiridh iad aithisg adhartais gu Bòrd na Gàidhlig ro 30 Ògmhios anns gach bhliadhna den chùrsa aca agus airson 3 bliadhna às dèidh dhaibh an cùrsa a chrìochnachadh

Thèid gach iarrtas a mheasadh a rèir dè an cùrsa a tha an neach-iarrtais a' dèanamh agus cò a' bhliadhna air a bheil iad. Bidh an taic-airgid a dh'fhaodas neach-iarrtais fhaotainn an crochadh air cia mheud bliadhna a bha iad ann an obair leantainneach mus do thòisich an cùrsa. Chithear mìneachadh gu h-ìosal.

To qualify for the top-up funding an applicant must:

- Have secured a place on a Gaelic-medium ITE course as stated on page 1
- Have been in continuous employment for a **minimum of a year prior** to their course starting
- Have a salaried income of no greater than £18,000 **for the duration of the course**
- Commit to a career in Gaelic Teaching for a minimum of 3 consecutive years
- Submit a progress report to Bòrd na Gàidhlig by 30th June of each year of their course and for 3 years following the course

Applications will be assessed according to the course and year of study of each applicant. The funding available to each applicant will be dependent on the number of years in continuous employment prior to the course starting as stated in the tables below.

The maximum amount of top-up funding an applicant can be in receipt of is £4,000 (total grant funding of £5,000).

Faodaidh cuideachd an àireamh de dhaoine a tha cur a-steach airson tabhartasan a bharrachd buaidh a thoirt air an t-sùim dheireannach a thèid a phàigheadh, agus bidh e cuideachd an crochadh air mar a thèid am buidseat maoinachaidh a riarachadh.

An cois iarrrtas airson tabhartas a bharrachd feumar fianais a thoirt dhuinn air:

- An ùine agaibh ann an obair mus do thòisich an cùrsa (me cùmhnant / bileagan-pàighidh / litir bho luchd-fastaidh)
- Teachd-a-steach a tha sibh an dùil a chosnadh rè ùine a' chùrsa

Cumhachan Maoineachaidh

Feumaidh **neach sam bith** a gheibh taic-airgid tron sgeama seo aontachadh ris na leanas:

- Gun cuir iad crìoch air a' chùrsa teagaisg Gàidhlig
- Gun cuir iad aithisg adhartais gu Bòrd na Gàidhlig ro 30 Ògmhios 2015
- Gun dèan iad teagasg ann am FtG airson co-dhiù a' bhliadhna dhearbhaidh aca

Cuideachd, feumaidh neach sam bith a gheibh **tabhartas a bharrachd** aontachadh ris na leanas:

- Co-dhiù 3 bliadhna às dèidh a chèile a chur seachad ann an teagasg Gàidhlig
- Aithisg adhartais a chur gu Bòrd na Gàidhlig ro 30 Ògmhios anns gach bhliadhna den chùrsa aca agus airson 3 bliadhna às dèidh dhaibh an cùrsa a chrìochnachadh

The final sum paid out may also be affected by the number of applicants seeking top-up grant funding and is subject to the funding budget allocation.

If applying for top-up funding, evidence must be provided of:

- Time in employment prior to the course starting (e.g. contract / payslips / letter from employer)
- Any income likely to be earned for the duration of the course

Conditions of Funding

Anyone in receipt of funding under this scheme must adhere to the following conditions:

- Completion of the Gaelic Teacher Education Course
- The submission of a progress report to Bòrd na Gàidhlig by 30th of June 2015
- To teach in GME for at least the probationary year

Those who are in receipt of **top-up funding** must also agree to:

- Commit to a career in Gaelic Teaching for a minimum of 3 consecutive years
- The submission of a progress report to Bòrd na Gàidhlig by 30th June of each year of their course and for 3 years following the course

Maoinachadh a bharrachd bho thobraichean eile

Ma tha luchd-iarrtais a' cur a-steach airson taic-airgid mu choinneamh chisean cùrsa no tabhartas a bharrachd airson Glusad gu Dreuchd ann an Teagasg Gàidhlig, feumaidh iad fiosrachadh a thoirt seachad mu thaic-airgid sam bith eile a fhuair iad, no taic-airgid a tha gu bhith tighinn bho bhuidhnean eile. Ma tha luchd-iarrtais a' faotainn taic-airgid bho bhuidheann sam bith eile, feumaidh iad seo a nochdadh gu soilleir san fhoirm-iarrtais aca agus bheirear beachd air seo.

Mar eisimpleir, ma tha neach-iarrtais a' cur a-steach airson taic-airgid mu choinneamh chisean cùrsa nuair a tha iad air taic fhaighinn bhon SAAS cuideachd (agus sin a' gabhail a-steach nuair a tha iad a' faighinn pàirt de na cìsean aca air am pàigheadh), feumaidh iad sin innse gu soilleir san fhoirm-iarrtais.

Fiosrachadh a bharrachd

Bu chòir pàipearan iomchaidh a bharrachd a chur gu Bòrd na Gàidhlig còmhla ris an fhoirm-iarrtais. Faodaidh luchd-iarrtais fiosrachadh iomchaidh sam bith eile a chur thugainn an cois an fhoirm-iarrtais aca.

Tha làn-chead aig Bòrd na Gàidhlig tuilleadh fiosrachaidh iarraidh a thaobh an iarrtais.

An Ceann-latha airson iarrtasan

Bu chòir iarrtasan airson taic-airgid a chur a-steach gu Bòrd na Gàidhlig cho luath 's a ghabhas, agus ro **Diluain 15^{mh} Sultain 2014**. Bu chòir do luchd-iarrtais fios a chur chun an Oifigeir Trusaidh Luchd-teagaisg aig Bòrd na Gàidhlig cho luath 's a ghabhas ma bhios ceist aca mu iarrtasan.

Dè thachras nuair a gheibh Bòrd na Gàidhlig iarrtas?

Thèid freagairt a chur chun an neach-iarrtais a' dearbhadh gun d' fhuaras an t-iarrtas aca. Gheibh an neach-iarrtais fios mun cho-dhùnadh a thaobh an iarrtais aca cho luath 's as urrainn às dèidh ceann-latha an sgeama.

Ma thèid gabhail ri iarrtas, thèid litir a chur chun an neach-iarrtais, ag innse dè an uiread de thaic-airgid a fhuair iad agus dè na cùmhnantan is cumhachan a tha an lùib an taic-airgid. Bidh aig luchd-iarrtais a shoirbhich an uair sin ri dearbhadh gu bheil iad a' gabhail ris an tairgse, mus tèid an t-airgead a phàigheadh.

Ma tha neach-iarrtais a' faighinn taic-airgid mu choinneamh chisean cùrsa, pàighidh Bòrd na Gàidhlig gu dìreach an t-airgead sin don ionad foghlaim iomchaidh. Ma

Additional funding from other sources

If applying for course fees or top-up grant funding for Changing to a Career in Gaelic Teaching, applicants must provide full details of any other funding approvals, or pending funding from other organisations. If applicants are receiving support from any other organisations this must be clearly stated on the application form and will be taken into consideration.

For example, if applicants are applying for support with course fees and are receiving support (including part-payment of fees) from SAAS, then this must also be stated clearly on the application form.

Additional information

Relevant supporting documents should be submitted to Bòrd na Gàidhlig with the application form. All applicants are also welcome to submit any additional relevant information supporting their application.

Bòrd na Gàidhlig reserves the right to ask for further information regarding the application.

Closing date for applications

Applications for funding should be submitted to Bòrd na Gàidhlig as soon as possible and no later than **Monday 15th September 2014**. Applicants should contact the Gaelic Teacher Recruitment Officer at Bòrd na Gàidhlig as soon as possible if they have any queries on the application process.

What happens after an application is submitted?

An acknowledgement will be sent to applicants to confirm their application has been received. Applicants will be informed of the decision on their application as soon as possible after the closing date.

If an application is approved, a letter will be issued to the applicant setting out the level of funding offered and the terms and conditions under which the funding will be paid. Successful applicants will then be required to confirm their acceptance of the offer before the money is paid.

If an applicant is receiving support with course fees, this will be paid by Bòrd na Gàidhlig directly to the education institution which they are attending. If awarded a grant

What information will Bòrd na Gàidhlig require during the funding period?

Bòrd na Gàidhlig will require an end of course report. The benefit of the course, as well as future teaching plans, should be detailed in the report.

Bòrd na Gàidhlig members of staff may also contact applicants during their course, for informal progress updates.

Bòrd na Gàidhlig may mention any assistance provided to individuals through this fund in the Bòrd's own publicity materials.

What happens if an applicant does not complete their course or continue to a career in Gaelic Education?

Should an applicant not complete their course, or decide not to follow a career in Gaelic Education, Bòrd na Gàidhlig must be informed immediately. Any monies received must also be returned and a repayment schedule will be agreed with Bòrd na Gàidhlig.

Will there be further opportunities to apply to this fund?

This is the only opportunity to apply for funding during this financial year, 2014-15. Further opportunities to apply for funding may be available next year and more information will be published on Bòrd na Gàidhlig's websites.
